

SPECIAL BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY
MAY 15, 2014

The Board of Public Works and Safety met in special session at the Knox City Hall at 9:00 AM CST on May 15, 2014 with the following members present: Mayor, Rick Chambers; Clerk-Treasurer, Jeff Houston; Boardmember, Ed Blue and City attorney Dave Matsey. Boardmember Jim Collins was absent.

RE: ACCEPT BIDS ON SIDEWALK PROGRAM

Mayor Chambers said the sidewalk bid was \$20,770.00 for the 50/50 program and \$1,625.00 for the ADA corners for a total bid of \$22,395.00 for Covenant Concrete. Kutchel Concrete was \$34,155.00 total bid. City Attorney Matsey and MVH Superintendent Jeff Borg went over the bids with the contractors. Covenant Concrete was the low bidder. Rick Chambers made a motion, seconded by Ed Blue to accept the bid by Covenant Concrete. Motion passed with Two (2) ayes and No (0) nays.
