

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY
JUNE 15, 2015

The Board of Public Works and Safety met in a special session at the Knox City Hall at 9:30 AM CST with the following members present: Mayor, Rick Chambers; Clerk-Treasurer, Jeff Houston; Boardmembers, Ed Blue and Jim Collins. City Attorney Dave Matsey was absent.

✓ The following street paving bids were opened on June 8, 2015:

Walsh & Kelly	1,051 ton	\$90,578.25 = \$86.18 per ton
Reith Riley	1,129 ton	\$72,567.00 = \$64.27 per ton
E & B	1,003 ton	\$71,990.00 = \$71.74 per ton

We originally accepted the low bid of E & B Paving of \$71,990.00, pending the approval of the Street Superintendent and City Attorney.

Upon a closer review by all parties it was found that with Reith Riley, we were actually getting an additional 125.5 tons of asphalt for the additional \$577.00.

It was the opinion of the MVH Superintendent Jeff Borg that the bid by # & B of 1003 tons was an insufficient amount of material to meet the spec of a two inch overlay of the street. As a result, Reith Riley's bid was actually the lowest due to the per ton price of the material.

Boardmember Collins asked about City Attorney Matsey's opinion on the matter and the Mayor said Mr. Matsey saw no problem with accepting the lowest per ton bid.

Mayor Chambers made a motion seconded by Ed Blue to accept Reith Riley's bid. Motion passed with Three (3) ayes and No (0) nays.

There being no further business to come before the board at this time the meeting upon motion was duly adjourned.
