- 1. The Sewer Department needs a new Vac Truck. The vehicle quote is \$562,610.00. We are using the Indiana Bond Bank for Funding; the Crossroads Bank has approved our funding of \$362,610.00 at 4.528%. The Vac Truck will be built to our needs and will be ready in May 2025. A down payment of \$200,000.00 will be paid out of the ARP Fund.
- 2. A new will for the City Water System is also needed currently. Peerless Midwest will be doing the new well at a cost of \$179,680.00. The project will start in late 2024 and be paid for out of the ARP Fund.
- 3. Currently the Police Department is down two officers. A new officer was just hired, his name is Joe West.
- 4. Looking for a new crossing guard, it's 45 minutes in the morning and in the afternoon. It pays \$33.67 a day.
- 5. The Fall Bash went very well. Jolly Roger sounds better and better each time they perform. The band Blammo was great, it took three years to get them here but well worth it!

RE: COUNCIL ITEMS

Bill Gustafson asked where the band Blammo is from? Mayor Estok informed the Council that they are from the South Bend/ Mishawaka area.
